



Boronia Heights State School is a uniform school. All students are required to wear the approved uniform, which reflects our community standards, promotes belonging, and meets sun safety guidelines. Uniforms also help identify students as part of our school.

- **Wearing full school uniform is compulsory for all students from Prep to Year 6 unless otherwise advised.**
- **Cultural and religious clothing needs will be respectfully discussed with school administration.**



Uniform Requirements

- School polo shirt with logo (royal blue, red, and white).
- Royal blue shorts, skort, or netball skirt.
- Bike pants/skins may be worn under shorts only and must not be visible.
- Royal blue wide-brim or bucket hat with logo (Prep students wear red-brimmed hats).
- Closed-in joggers or leather shoes with white socks.
- Royal blue long pants.
- School long-sleeve polo shirt (royal blue, red, and white).
- Royal blue jumper or jacket, or school jacket with logo.
- Undergarments worn for warmth must not be visible (no skivvies under short-sleeve polos).
- Year 6: commemorative short-sleeve polo.
- Sports Day: students may wear a house-coloured shirt.

Clothing not listed above is not permitted

If a student is unexpectedly out of uniform, parents/carers must notify the school by phone, note, or in person. Substitute items should match school colours and meet uniform standards. Denim, singlets, miniskirts/mini shorts, and open shoes are not allowed.

Jewellery

- Only a wristwatch and small stud or sleeper earrings are permitted.
- No other jewellery except Medic Alert items.
- No facial or body piercings.

Hair

- Hair at shoulder length or longer must be tied back, for all students.
- Hair dye must be a natural colour close to the student's own.
- Extreme hairstyles or obvious hair products are not allowed.
- Hair accessories must be royal blue, red, or white.
- No coloured hair, including on Sports Day.

Body Art & Nails

- No fake nails, nail polish, nail art, make-up, or temporary tattoos.
- Permanent tattoos are illegal for those under 18.

Parent/Carer Responsibilities

- Parents/carers must provide and maintain the correct uniform and clearly label all items so they can be returned if lost
