What are we learning this term?

English	In this unit, students will listen to, view and interpret a range of multimodal messages, to respond to guiding questions and to create a range of letters/email for different audiences and purposes. Students will produce a message to a chosen audience.
Mathematics	In this unit, students apply a variety of mathematical concepts in real-life, lifelike and purely mathematical situations. Students have opportunities to develop understandings of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Using Units of Measurement - Data Representation and Interpretation
Science (Apryl Albon)	The 'Weather In My World' unit enables students to use their senses to explore and observe the weather in their local environment and learn that we can record our observations using symbols. Students observe that weather can change and identify the features that reflect a change in the weather. They are given opportunities to reflect on the impact of these changes on themselves, in particular on clothing, shelter and activities, through various cultural perspectives. They begin to realise that weather conditions are not the same for everyone. Students also learn about the impact of daily and seasonal changes on plants and animals
Technologies - Digital	In this unit, students describe the purpose of familiar products, services and environments and how they meet a range of present needs. They list the features of technologies that influence design decisions and identify how digital systems are used.
