The Department of Education have introduced new medication forms to be used from 19th April 2022 (Term 2).

Every medication that is administered daily or held in the office to administer "as needed" requires a Consent to Administer Medication form to be completed, signed and returned to the office. If your child has several medications at school we will require a Consent Form to be completed for each medicine. This also includes asthma puffers, epi pens and any antihistamines and creams to treat allergies.

We have enclosed the necessary forms and kindly ask that you please complete, sign and return to the office as soon as possible.

If your child has Allergies, Asthma or is at risk of Anaphylaxis please ensure the most recent Action Plan is attached.
